Unfortunately, some disruptions cannot be avoided in order for the works to be carried out, however in most cases we are able to implement accommodations which could make a huge difference to our clients.

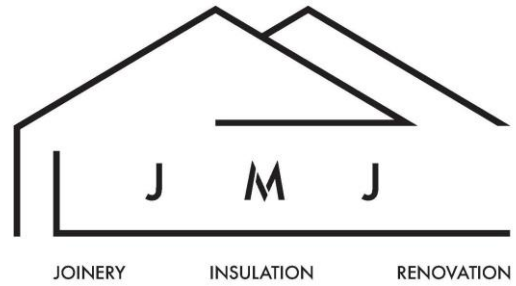
Primarily, we want you to feel comfortable with us, any information provided will be shared only with the team members conducting and overseeing works at your residence. For our full privacy policy please go to our website.

e.g., wear PPE including face mask if interacting with me.

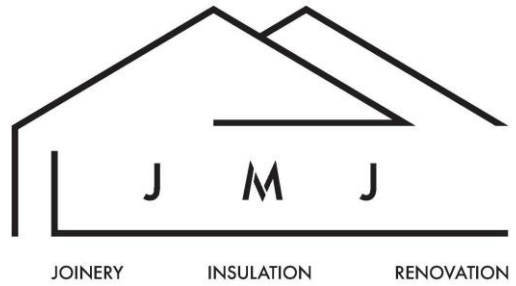
e.g., do not play any music in your area of work.
